








- First BC public institution with US accreditation (NWCCU)










AFTER ENTERING ALL THE NECESSARY INFORMATION




AFTER CLICKING "ENTER PERSONAL INFORMATION" (FROM SLIDE 4)









3D ANIMATION FOR FILM AND GAMES DIPLOMA SELECTED AS FIRST CHOICE




ARTS ASSOCIATE DEGREE - PSYCHOLOGY AS SECOND CHOICE


